## Series 1: Entrepreneurs and small businesses seeking Investors

A three-day virtual and inhouse technical training course on Investments will be organised and facilitated through collaborative efforts of the Dominica Youth Business Trust (DYBT), International Organisation for Migration (IOM) and Invest Dominica Authority (IDA) and Eastern Caribbean Central Bank as part of Financial Literacy Month. The course runs from Tuesday-Thursday October 13-15, 2020 at the Eastern Caribbean Central Bank (ECCB) Agency Office Conference Room on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Floor of the Financial Centre in Roseau. The opening programme will start at 2:30 p.m. on Tuesday 13th October, 2020 and the course presentations and discussions will be facilitated by Mr. Michel Williams, Managing Director of Navigant Consulting Services, member of Institute of Chartered Accountants of the Eastern Caribbean (ICAEC).

This course is intended to target young entrepreneurs who are seeking potential investors to grow their businesses. Participants will be equipped with knowledge of Investments, inclusive of; what to expect of an investor, different modes of investment, costs vs. benefits of bringing investors on board, common mistakes/things to look out for.
