Reference: Disturbing recent video of a baby no more than 2 years old, sent to my attention over the weekend, being sodomised and sexually abused.

Sir/Madam,

I write this open letter of concern as an active/ contributing Dominican living in Canada and very disturbed at what was sent to me to address in confidence.

My name is Janice Williams aka Swinging Janice and founder of the Non-profit Organization,

The Swinging Janice Scholarship Foundation, now operating in Dominica.

Let me make it clear that I speak a language of early sexual molestation and extreme poverty. Let me also state for the record that I have been advocating for the vulnerable, poor sick and needy, as young as 12 years old.

Now having said that, I have dedicated myself to be involved in the protection of the young among us and over the years I have in my possession over 50 complains of sexual rape, sexual sodomization and on the weekend this traumatising video sent to me was the worst I event I have ever come across. It was sent not for the sake of sharing but because they wanted me to take some action for the innocent child.

I would like to ask you Mr. Police Commissioner, and you Mr. Honourable Prime Minister Mr. Skerrit, and you the Manager of the Welfare Department, and to all the media houses that I am addressing this letter to, have the perpetrator of the heinous crime been arrested?

I also want to ask, have the media been following up on this serious epidemic called Child Sexual Abuse and Rape, being reported all over the island at this moment?

And to the welfare department I want to ask, how many more young girls and boys must complain about being raped and nothing being done for them?

Please do not say that "I live in Canada and do not know what I am talking about." I have the evidence and can back up my questions and statements.

The youngest in our society needs protection from predators, sexual monsters and fathers and so-called stepfathers who think, that they can sexually abuse their children and get away with it.

Please, to the authorities, toughen the child sexual abuse laws and grant no bail to such offenders and child molesters and child rapists.

To the Honourable Prime Minister I ask, please do something to keep babies from being raped and sodomised and please reform the police laws so it can be clear that such acts should not be tolerated in our society and the police officers in every village in Dominica should operate from one manual and that manual should read arrest and charge sex predators and grant no bail to those offenders.

I am not a Diasporian, but rather, a true born Dominican who loves her country and loves her people. We need justice.

I and many women who know what it is to be sexually abused, know what devastating effects can occur if years of child abuse is not dealt with. I am calling on you Mr. Police Commissioner, Mr. Daniel Carbon that take immediate action because what has occurred on the island is a serious sexual crime and if there was any bail in that crime, that bail should be revoked.

Let me congratulate you Mr. Honourable Prime Minister on the development in the country and all the beautiful infrastructure that now surfaces. That is why I know Sir; you will take this matter very seriously. If you are not aware of the crime that took place recently, please investigate the matter on behalf of that 2 years old child and her mother.

We crying JUSTICE for baby X.

I know we are better than that as a society. I know if we toughen the laws and lock these law breakers of and grant no bail to sexual crimes, es

especially when it occurs between nine months to 16 years old.
